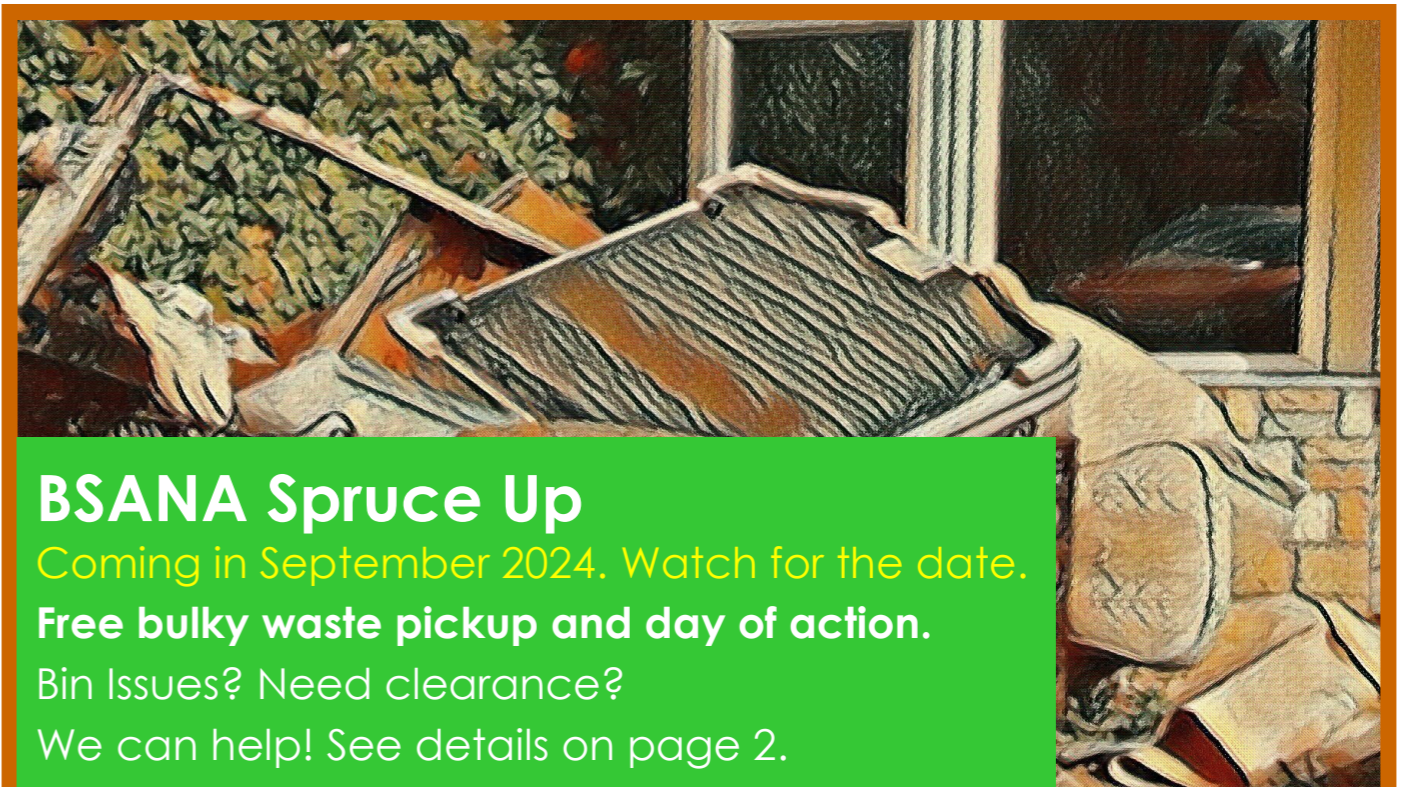

**Free bulky waste collection and litter pick day of action. September 2024. Date to be announced.**

We will be working with the Council to mobilise a day of action around cleaning the Oxford Road area. We are teaming up with the Oxford Road Safer Neighbourhood Forum and the Victoria Park Residents Association (north of the Oxford Road) to bring a lift to our neighbourhoods.

We may also be able to arrange for removal of contaminated red recycling bins or grey waste bins ... **but you must contact us.**
